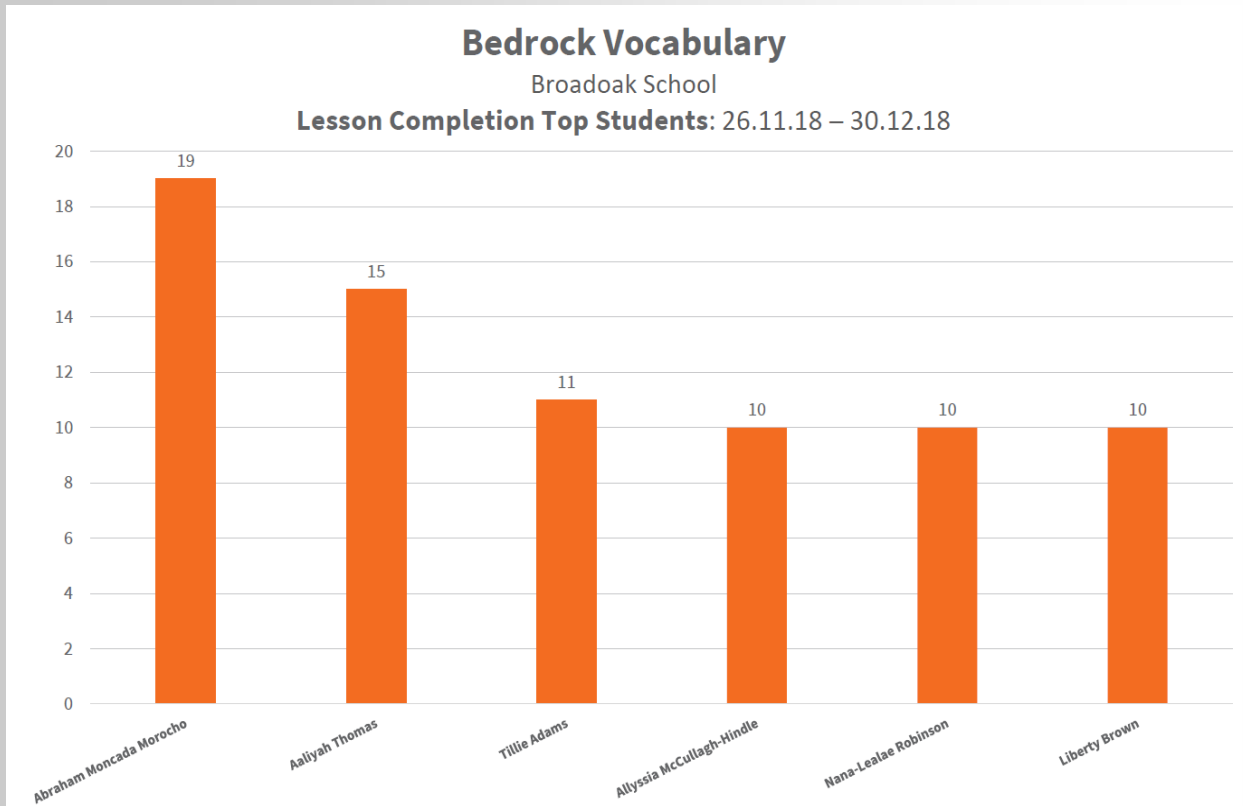

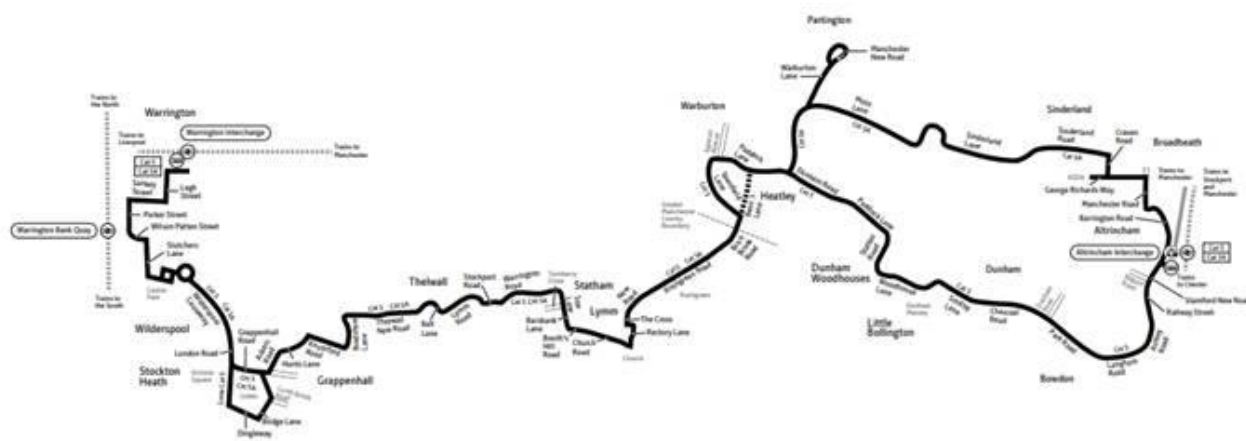
CC5A Altrincham to Warrington bus route
