

# Broadoak School Behaviour Sanction Staircase

## First Verbal Warning

- Strategy used to address unacceptable behaviour which is affecting the learning of others and stopping the teacher teaching.
- Pupil spoken to by the teacher with an explanation of why the behaviour is not acceptable.
- Pupil informed that this is their first warning

## Final Verbal Warning

- Pupil fails to engage following the behaviour management strategy.
- Pupil spoken to by the teacher with an explanation of why the behaviour is unacceptable.
- A final verbal warning is issued. Pupil informed that if they disrupt /affect the learning of others on one more occasion then they will be removed.

## Pupil Removed

**Pupil behaviour is still unacceptable and is affecting the learning of others and stopping the teacher teaching.**

- Pupil spoken to by the teacher with an explanation of why the behaviour is still unacceptable and why they are getting removed
- 45 minute after-school detention with class teacher
- If the pupil does not leave the class when removed or if the pupil fails to go to Student Services, they will be placed into INTEX the following day.
- If the pupil fails to attend or complete the remove detention to an acceptable standard, they will be placed into INTEX the following day
- If a pupil 'Self Removes' from a lesson they will be placed into INTEX the following day
- If a pupil is 'Red Card' Removed then the pupil will go straight into INTEX for the rest of the day and will complete a further day in INTEX.
