Stand out performers were Ruben Dunn Y8 and Jake Martyn Y10 who both finished 2nd place in the 4k competition.

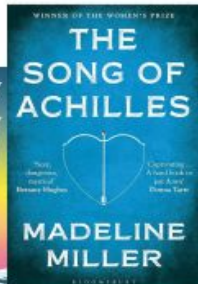
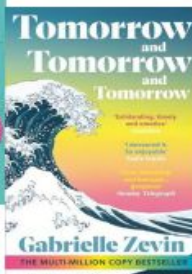
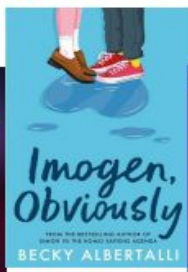
