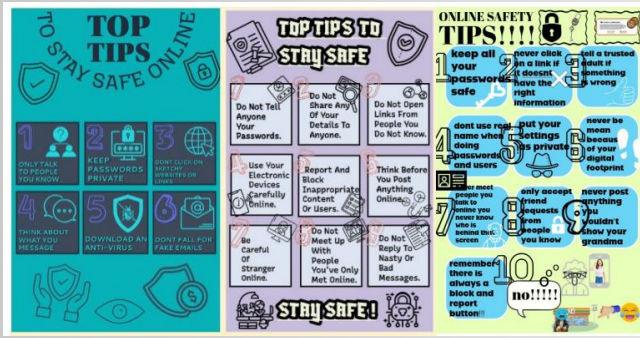

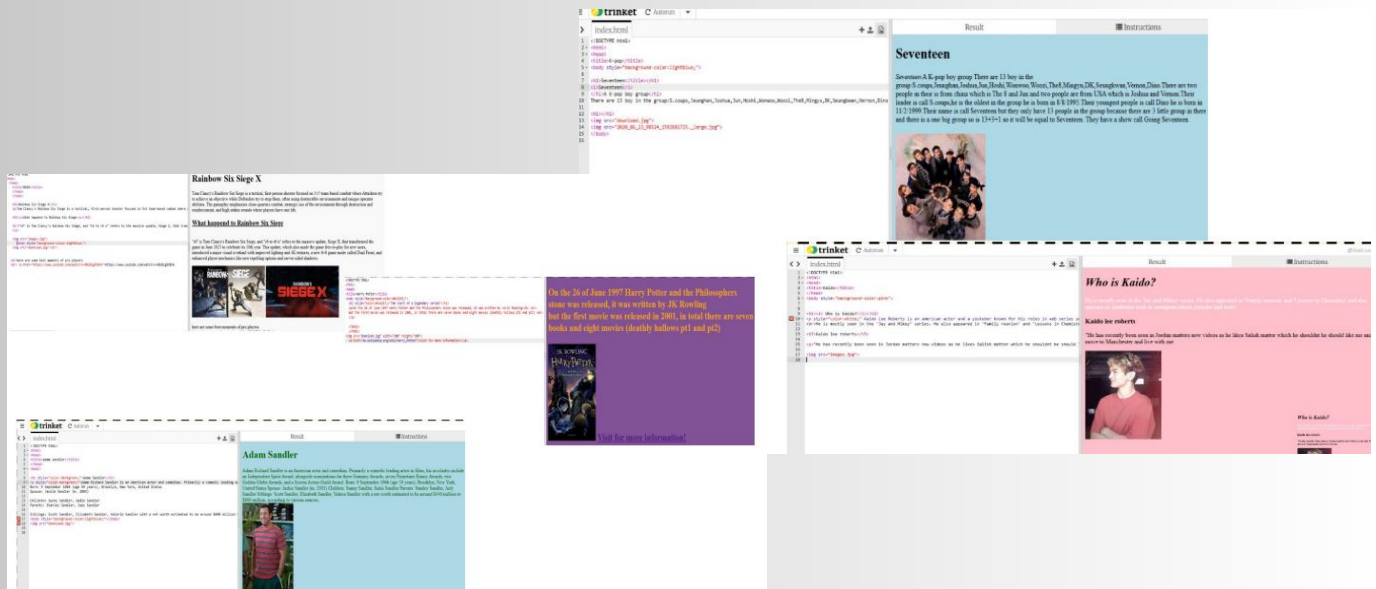

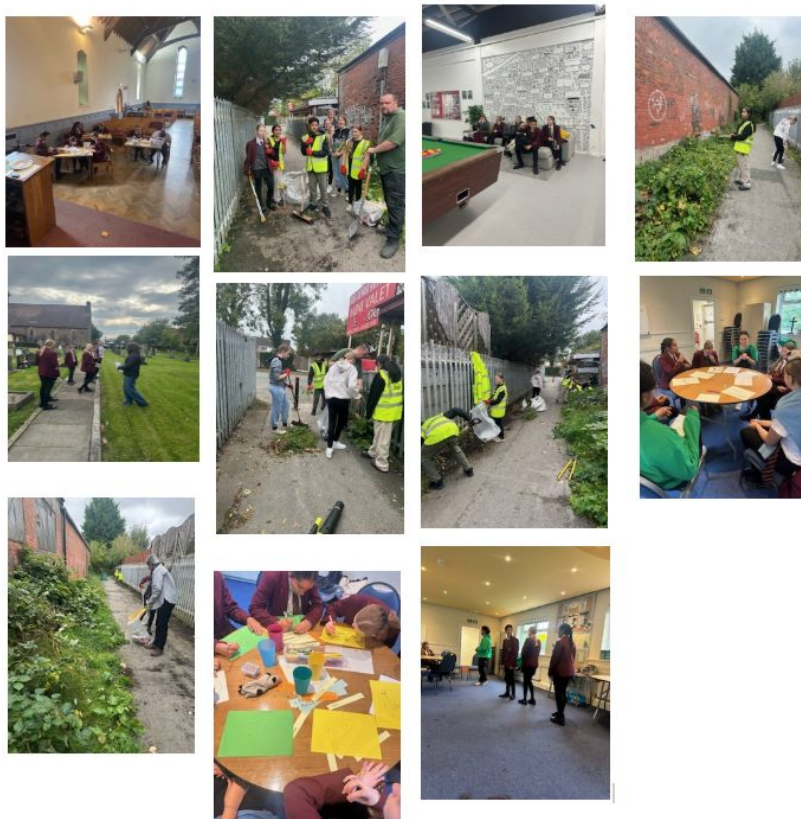
Max travelled to Belfast with his darts academy last weekend where Max made it to the semi finals. He came up against some tough opponents who play for Northern Ireland.
