This week, our pupils attend a STEM trip to the Williams Racing Experience Centre, where the world of Formula 1 became their classroom. The core of the visit was a high-energy STEM workshop where pupils acted as lead engineers to design and build their own F1 nose cones. 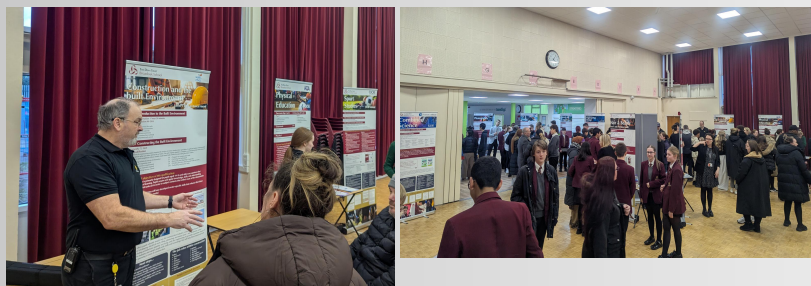
