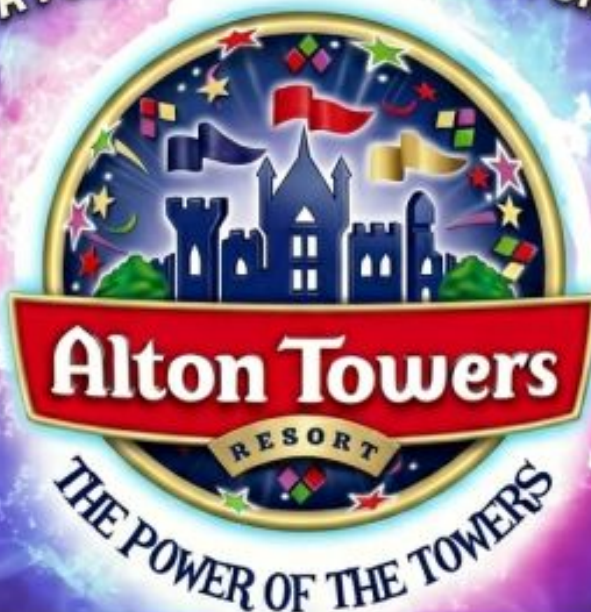
British Street Party
